

## **Classmate Obituary – Ralph L. Bustos (17 September 1968)**

Services for Ralph L. Bustos, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Bustos, Box 38A, Campbell's Island, will be at 9:30 Friday morning in the Primm-Sullivan Chapel, and at 10 in St. Mary's Catholic Church, East Moline. Burial will be in Calvary Cemetery, Rock Island.

The liturgy will be recited at 8 tomorrow night in the funeral home, where friends may call after 2 tomorrow afternoon.

Bustos was found dead yesterday in an unoccupied house near the Bustos home. Rock Island County sheriff's deputies said Bustos was found by his mother about 2:30 p.m.

Rock Island County Coroner James L. Shaw said an inquest tentatively has been scheduled for 10 Monday morning in the court house. Shaw said a .22 caliber rifle was found beside the body.

Mr. Bustos was born in Moline. He graduated from St. Mary's Grade School and UTHS both in East Moline.

He had been employed in construction work.

Surviving in addition to his parents are three brothers, Raymond of Sterling, Robert of Vandenburg Air Force Base, Calif., and Ronald, at home; four sisters, -- Ramona, Rita, Rosemary and Rebecca, all at home, and his maternal grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Melvin Burmeister, Rock Island.
