

Teacher Obituary - Joseph Dhondt (16 November 2005)



Funeral services for Joseph F. Dhondt, 76, of East Moline, will be 1 p.m. Saturday at St. Anne Catholic Church, East Moline. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery, East Moline. Visitation will be 2-8 p.m. today at the Van Hoe Funeral Home Ltd., East Moline, where a rosary will be recited at 8 p.m.
